FORT HUNTER LIGGETT, Calif. – Media are invited to cover Brigadier General Jon D. Lee's retirement ceremony on April 26 at 11am.

Brig. Gen. Lee is a distinguished military graduate of the University of Santa Clara with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Commerce. He received his commission as a second lieutenant as an infantry officer in June 1984. His prior assignment include various positions in the 100th Battalion/442nd Infantry and the 9th Army Reserve Command at Fort DeRussy, Hawaii; Commander of the 4960th Multi Functional Training Brigade at Fort Shafter, Hawaii; and as the Deputy Commanding General of the 63rd Regional Support Command, Moffet Field, California. He was mobilized in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and served as Chief of Operations for Combined Joint Task Force 7 from October 2003 to April 2004.

The 91st TD conducts Warrior and Combat Support Training Exercises in order to train units on collective tasks so they are prepared for deployment. The 91st TD is recognized as the Army Reserve's premier training organization to assist Operational and Functional, Combined and Joint Commands in training and assessing unit readiness.
