FORT HUNTER LIGGETT CHANGE OF COMMAND CEREMONY

FORT HUNTER LIGGETT, Calif. – The FHL Change of Command Ceremony is scheduled on July 14 at 9am.

Lt. Col. Michael B. Bailey will relinquish the command to Col. Jan C. Norris, who hails from Richmond, Va. Bailey will resume his duties as the Deputy Commander.

Col. Norris' last assignments was at the Pentagon. Prior to that, he has served as the Commander of the 4th Joint Communications Squadron (Airborne)-Joint Communications Support Element, MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa, Fla. And as the Assistant Chief of Staff, G6 for the 311th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) in Los Angeles, Calif. He was stationed in Hawaii from 2007-2010 in various key positions as S3-516th Signal Brigade, S3-30th Signal Battalion and Chief of Current Operations for the 311th Signal Command (Theater) at Fort Shafter. Norris' most recent deployment was as Chief, Current Operations for the 335th Signal Command Forward at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait in 2009.
