Command Sergeant Major Kevin Newman arrived at Fort Hunter Liggett in August 2010 from Lessons Learned and Quality Assurance as Directorate Sergeant Major at Fort Lee, Va.

Command Sergeant Major Newman attended basic training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina in June 1983, and went on to Fort Eustis, Va., to attend Advanced Individual Training where he was awarded the MOS 68D (Aircraft Power-Train Repairer). Command Sergeant Major Newman attended the U.S. Army Basic Parachutist Course at Fort Benning, Ga., and after being awarded his parachutist badge was assigned to Bravo Troop 1st Squadron (Air)/17th Cavalry at Fort Bragg, N.C.

In 1986, Command Sergeant Major Newman entered the Army Reserve as an 11B Infantryman and was assigned to the 3rd Battalion/87th Infantry in Aurora Company. In 1990, Command Sergeant Major Newman entered the Active Guard and Reserve (AGR) program. Since then Command Sergeant Major Newman has served as the Armament Repair Instructor at the Regional Training Site Maintenance, Fort Hood, Texas; as an Army Reserve Recruiter in Richland Hills, Texas; as the Senior Maintenance Supervisor for the 475th Quartermaster Company, with whom he deployed to Iraq in 2003. Command Sergeant Major Newman was the Senior Maintenance Supervisor Sergeant Major for the Civil Affairs and Psychological Operations Command at Fort Bragg, N.C. In 2006, Command Sergeant Major Newman deployed to Afghanistan with the USACAPOC G-4.

Command Sergeant Major Newman holds an AAS degree in Electronic Engineering Technology and is currently working toward a Bachelor of Arts degree from Liberty University. Other schooling includes the Basic Infantryman Course, Jungle Operations Course, Tank Turret Repair Course, Instructor Training Course, M1074 PLS Operator / DS Maintenance Course, and the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy.
