

FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2016 ANNUAL REPORT:

**PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG  
U.S. ARMY GARRISON FORT HUNTER LIGGETT,  
THE CALIFORNIA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER,  
AND THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION  
REGARDING OFF-ROAD VEHICLE MANEUVER MILITARY TRAINING AT  
FORT HUNTER LIGGETT, CALIFORNIA**

The U.S. Army Garrison (USAG) Fort Hunter Liggett submits the following annual report to the California State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and concurring parties in accordance with Stipulation IX of the *Programmatic Agreement among the U.S. Army Garrison Fort Hunter Liggett, the California State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation regarding Off-Road Vehicle Maneuver Military Training at Fort Hunter Liggett, California*, hereafter referred to as the PA. This report covers the period from start of the PA, June 2, 2016, through September 30, 2016, and includes information as outlined in Stipulation IX.A. **1. Summary of progress made in implementing Stipulations II, III, IV, V, and XIII**

Stipulation II: Between June 2, 2016 and September 30, 2016, there were 55 exempt training activities in the maneuver corridors. Five undertakings were non-training exempt activities. There was only one off-road heavy vehicle maneuver training for the reporting period and it is described in part 3 below.

Stipulation III: Thirty-nine (39) sites were evaluated for eligibility for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, with 11 being determined ineligible, and 28 sites as eligible. Determinations of Eligibility will be submitted to SHPO for concurrence when the evaluation reports are finalized. Sites evaluated are listed in Appendix A. No new inventory occurred in the reporting period but is planned for next year.

Stipulation IV: A total of 235 sites were protected using Seibert stakes (or tall orange cones in parachute drop zones). An additional 187 sites are considered protected with nominal or administrative restrictions where off-road heavy vehicle maneuvers will not occur. These are shown in Appendix B.

Stipulation V: Monitoring of the sites in the maneuver corridors during the reporting period indicated that of 434 sites within the Area of Potential Effect, a total of 22 sites were driven across. Soil conditions were dry, and there did not appear to be significant damage or other ground disturbance, such as digging, observed. Information is provided in Appendix C.

Stipulation XIII: An annual Cultural Awareness Training is planned for January 2017 at the combined WAREX/CSTX Planning Conference for 2017 to reach all training planners for the 2017 summer exercises at FHL. Additional educational awareness materials were provided to Soldiers for smaller exercises throughout the year, and Soldier Field Pocket Cards are provided to field personnel.

**2. Summary of Non-Training Exempted Undertakings in the APE**

Five non-training exempt undertakings occurred in the Maneuver Corridors during the reporting period (Table 1). There were 55 Exempt Undertakings for training during the reporting period.

There were no undertakings in the APE requiring further review and coordination under Section 106 of the NHPA in accordance with 36 CFR §§ 800.3 through 800.7.

**3. Summary of maneuver training exercises conducted during the annual report period, and any planned or scheduled for the next reporting period:**

One Off-Road Heavy Vehicle exercise occurred from August 11-15, 2016. The activity took place in the maneuver area in Training Area 3 and consisted of a platoon level activity by the 315<sup>th</sup> Engineering Battalion. A tank breach obstacle exercise using both heavy wheeled and tracked vehicles off-road was conducted. Nearby sites have been marked, and the training unit was briefed regarding sensitive resource areas to avoid prior to the exercise. No impacts to nearby cultural resources occurred during this exercise.

Off-Road Heavy Vehicle Maneuver Training for the next reporting period is scheduled to occur in June and July of 2017.

**4. Status of cultural awareness training, per Stipulation VI:**

An annual Cultural Awareness Training is scheduled to be provided at the WAREX/CSTX Planning Conference in January 2017. Personnel involved in the Off-Road Heavy Vehicle Maneuver exercises for 2017 will be in attendance to include planners from participating Army units from other installations, Army Reserve tenants based at FHL, and FHL Range Control personnel who facilitate the exercises. The WAREX/CSTX exercise for May/June 2016 did not include Off-Road Heavy Vehicle Maneuvers. Off-Road Heavy Vehicle Maneuvers are being planned June/July 2017.

Cultural Awareness Training for the small scale maneuver exercise in August 2016 was provided to unit personnel prior to the action, along with maps of avoidance areas.

A cultural awareness briefing with post-monitoring information was provided at the Training Support Working Group meeting in September 15, 2016. Attendees included Range Control personnel and representatives from different military units training at FHL.

In addition, cultural awareness information is provided in the Soldiers Field Pocket Card, and on signage at Range Control.

**5. Inadvertent entry and/or effects identified through monitoring and/or inspection, to include actions taken to resolve any adverse effects:**

Post-exercise monitoring in the maneuver corridors showed that of the 434 sites within the Area of Potential Effect, a total of 22 sites were driven on during the reporting period. All sites were marked with Seibert stakes and/or cones. All cases appear to be done by lightweight vehicles/trucks and none were the result of heavy vehicles or tracked vehicle maneuvers. None of the sites were determined to have incurred significant impacts.

Four of the sites with vehicle tracks were due to wildfire emergencies. Two sites are on an existing firebreak that was re-opened in response to a wildfire. In both cases, the firebreak had been previously dozed and no new impacts were observed. Two other sites that had vehicle tracks were near an area where a fire had occurred. Dozing in response to the fire stayed outside of the marked sites.

Review of the effectiveness of the protection program so far has shown that Seibert stakes and cones have been effective, but they are not a guarantee. Additional staking and/or signage is needed to make protected areas more obvious from all directions, in addition to increased educational awareness outreach. Some of the impacts may have occurred during training events, but some may also be the result of public recreation activities. Additional educational outreach is needed to insure all visiting personnel are notified.

Additional stakes were placed on six transgressed sites where it was determined that the initial markings were not visible enough from all angles. Additional "No Vehicle" signs will be installed on sites as an added measure.

**6. Actions taken for the purpose of immediate rescue and salvage operations conducted to preserve life or property within a protected property per Stipulation IV (C):**

During the reporting period, two wildfires incidents occurred which led to fire suppression activity. Existing firebreaks were re-opened with bulldozers. Two sites in TA 3 have old firebreaks running through them dating back to the 1950's that were re-opened. Areas dozed were areas previously dozed decades ago, and did not impact intact deposits. Two other sites were near a small fire in training

area 12B. A dozer line was placed outside the sites to stop the fire, however truck vehicle tracks were observed within two sites.

**7. Issues raised by an interested party in the reporting period:**

No issues have been raised by an interested party during the reporting period.

**8. Updated listings of protected cultural resources and site protection measures:**

Appendix B contains the updated list of protected cultural resources sites and site protection measures. There are 434 sites identified in the APE. All but 12 sites have protection measures in place. Sites without protection measures are those sites determined to be ineligible for listing, or those not at risk from vehicles either because the site was never relocated in subsequent field visits or the historic property is of a nature that it would not likely be damaged by maneuver vehicles.

**9. New inventory reports and amended Maneuver Corridor maps:**

No new inventories have been conducted yet. The first four months have been dedicated to site protection, monitoring, and education. New inventories are scheduled for the current year and will be provided in the next annual report.

**10. Acknowledgment of, and mitigation strategies for, cumulative effects not previously identified:**

Additional mitigation strategies involve increased educational awareness for the non-training audience to include:

- 1) The Department of Morale, Welfare, and Recreation which runs the Hunt and Fish Program, to educate the public who have recreation permits to access the ranges.
- 2) The Department of Emergency Services, to assist with coordinating with educating outside state and local agencies for fire and emergency response. And,
- 3) The Department of Public Works for coordination with visiting staff and contractors brought on for short term projects, to insure newcomers receive briefings.

## Appendix A

### Evaluation and Inventory of Cultural Resources

Preliminary determinations of eligibility were made where possible, from visible surface data. If not enough surface information was available to make an evaluation, recommendations are made to conduct testing to determine eligibilities for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The list of sites evaluated is provided in Table 2, and will be provided to SHPO for concurrence when the preliminary evaluations are finalized. Results of the DOE consultations will be reported on next year.
