Fort Hunter Liggett Hunting Program Fee Structure

1. Fees are established annually for the Fort Hunter Liggett Hunting and Fishing Program by the Hunting Fee Structure Committee, based on program requirements and regulated conservation efforts. Represented on the fee structure committee are the Environmental and Recreation offices and the Garrison Command Group.
2. Fees collected for the Fort Hunter Liggett Hunting and Fishing Program are retained at Fort Hunter Liggett and used for a variety of purposes. In addition to covering the operating costs of the hunting and fishing program through the year, these fees are used for the protection, conservation, and management of fish and wildlife on the installation's more than 160,000 acres, including habitat restoration and improvement, biologist staff support, and related activities, as required in the federally approved Fish and Wildlife Cooperative Plan.
3. Feedback from our Soldiers and program participants is taken into account when determining yearly fee structure, but above all, mission and requirements must be met in order to continue to allow hunting as a recreational activity for all to enjoy at Fort Hunter Liggett. Staff benchmarked similar operations within a 250-mile radius of Fort Hunter Liggett and the resulting fee structure is a fraction of surrounding comparable program fees.
4. Some highlights for the 2013-2014 hunting season include:
 - a. Establishing a new reduced fee category for military veterans
 - b. Continuing to offer active duty military reduced fees on a sliding scale
 - c. Continuing to offer retirees a reduced fee
 - d. Continuing to offer youth hunting category at a reduced fee
 - e. Continuing to offer military members E4 and below free hunting opportunities
