

2013/14 FORT HUNTER LIGGETT PERMIT APPLICATION

How the Permit Process Works

- Step 1. You send us a completed **2013/14 Fort Hunter Liggett permit application** and a **copy of your valid 2013/14 California hunting license** by mail. Use of a previous year's or incomplete application will delay processing your application.
- Step 2. No personal checks accepted. You must include the correct fee in a money order or cashier's check payable to "**MWR US ARMY**".
- Step 3. You provide an e-mail address or self addressed, stamped envelope for confirmation.
- Step 4. We will process your application within two weeks of postmark date.
- Step 5. We will notify you by e-mail or mail that your application is processed.
- Step 6. You pick up your permit in person with current photo identification at the Fort Hunter Liggett Outdoor Recreation Hunting and Fishing check station.

Other Important Information


- Your 2013-14 annual hunting permit is valid from July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014, concurrent with the California hunting license year.
- Your 2013-14 two-day hunting permit is valid for **any one weekend** from July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014.
- Your permit application is not a reservation for hunting on a weekend.
- **Incomplete, Incorrect, or Illegible Applications will be Rejected.**
- Access for hunting in the training areas is on a first-come, first-served basis (except for the lottery system during the general deer season).
- Training area availability for hunting is determined by the military training schedule. There may be times when hunting opportunities are limited or unavailable due to military training requirements.
- Reduced Fee applicants (Active-duty enlisted Military, Veterans, Retirees and Youth) must submit a copy of their **DD214, front of valid CAC card or reduced fee California Department of Fish and Wildlife hunting license** with their application to verify reduced fee eligibility.
- All sales are final and not refundable or transferable between individuals or to another permit year.
- Fees are administered in the following manner: Conservation fees are used for habitat and wildlife management. Activity fees cover program administration, processing and management.
- **ALL weapons used on Fort Hunter Liggett must be registered with Directorate of Emergency Services using FHL Form 8 BEFORE use on Fort Hunter Liggett** per Army Regulation 190-11. DO NOT bring weapons onto cantonment until registered with Form 8 which can be found on the website at:
