DATA REQUIRED BY PRIVACY ACT

AUTHORITY: Title 10, Sec. 3012 (g) United States Code

PRINCIPAL PURPOSE: The Social Security number (SSN) is used for Law Enforcement purpose as an additional means of identification of subjects, suspects, witnesses and complaints.

ROUTINE USES: Your Social Security number is a major item used in processing machine record and output sequence for Military Management Information System.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS VOLUNTARY: However, failure to provide SSN may delay or preclude registration of a privately owned weapon on the military installation.

FIREARMS WILL NOT BE CARRIED CONCEALED

CLASS "A" REGISTRATION: Weapons may be kept in family and bachelor type quarters or Unit Arms Room. NEVER in troop barracks.

CLASS "B" REGISTRATION: Weapons are kept in Unit Arms Room ONLY. NEVER in troop barracks. This registration is subject to cancellation, permits to owner to carry unconcealed, the described firearm for use in authorized activities on the Installation.
