PRIVACY ACT OF 1974

AUTHORITY: 10 U.S.C., Section 3103. PURPOSE: To assist the commander in carrying out an effective law enforcement, crime prevention, and safety program. The home address and home phone number are required to enable FHL/PRFTA personnel to contact the registrant. ROUTINE USE: Information on weapons registration is furnished to Federal Bureau of Investigation, US Customs services, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, state and local law enforcement, etc., for investigation and prosecution when such cases fall within their jurisdiction. DISCLOSURE: Disclosure of the information is voluntary; however, failure to provide the information may result in not being allowed to register personal firearms.

USAG FORT HUNTER LIGGETT/PRFTA WEAPONS REGISTRATION

Registration Process

All privately owned weapons stored or transported on FHL/PRFTA will be registered with the Provost Marshal's Office.

Personnel will legibly complete an FHL Form 8 (Registration of Personal Firearms) and bring the form to a DES Registration Office. Offices are located in Bldg 235 on Fort Hunter Liggett or Bldg 790 on Parks Reserves Forces Training Area. **DO NOT BRING YOUR WEAPON INTO EITHER FACILITY.**

For non-affiliated civilian personnel the weapons registration form will be issued as valid for 12 months. Non-affiliated civilians must undergo annual security vetting in order to have the registration form extended. Individuals requesting to have the registration extended for an additional year must contact the Registration Office at (831) 386-3735 or 386-3332 FHL or 925-875-4720 to coordinate the conduct of the security vetting.

DoD Civilians and Military Retirees are not required to undergo annual vetting. The registration form will be issued as valid for 5 years.

**NOTE: 1. ON THE COLUMN TITLE "TYPE WEAPON/ACTION" PLEASE SPECIFIED WHAT TYPE OF WEAPON (I.E PISTOL, RIFLE, SHOTGUN, ETC).
2. A COPY OF YOUR "DRIVER LICENSE" ATTACHED WITH THIS FORM (FHL FORM 8-1, FT HUNTER LIGGETT REGISTRATION OF PERSONAL FIREARMS).**

Persons Prohibited from Possessing Firearms:

- Any person convicted of a felony.
- Any person convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence (Lautenberg Amendment).
- Any person who is a fugitive from justice.
- Any person who has been convicted in any court of the possession, use, or sale of marijuana, or dangerous, or narcotic drugs, to include non-judicial punishment under Article 15, UCMJ.
- Any person who is declared as mentally incompetent.

Storing / Transporting Personal Weapons

Weapons can only be carried in a vehicle when traveling to and from authorized hunting, target practice, matches, or off post locations.

When transporting weapons, they must be secured in the vehicle's trunk or, if the vehicle doesn't have a lockable trunk, encased in such a manner that it's not readily accessible to the driver or passengers.

Weapons must be transported unloaded and ammunition must be stored separately from the weapon.

The registration form must be readily available at all times while a weapon is located on FHL/PRFTA property.

When entering FHL/PRFTA vehicle occupants are required to declare the presence of any firearms located in the vehicle.

Concealed weapon permits are not valid on FHL/PRFTA.
