MEMORANDUM FOR USAG FHL Soldiers and Civilians

SUBJECT: FHL Policy #14, Fish and Wildlife Conservation Fund Fees for Hunting and Fishing on Fort Hunter Liggett

1. REFERENCE.

- a. AR 200-1 Environmental Protection and Enhancement, 27 August 2008
- b. Sikes Act, 16 U.S.C. 670a, et seq. (as amended, 2004)
- c. CSTC Policy #14, Fish and Wildlife Conservation Fund Fees for Hunting and Fishing on Fort Hunter Liggett, 23 May 2008.
- d. California Fish and Game Code, Section 7150 & Section 7151

2. PURPOSE. To provide guidance to Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) Soldiers and civilians on permit fees for hunting and fishing on FHL.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all persons purchasing FHL permits for hunting and fishing. This policy supersedes CSTC Policy #14 – Fish and Wildlife Conservation Fund Fees for Hunting and Fishing on Fort Hunter Liggett dated 23 May 2008.

4. POLICY. The collection of Fish and Wildlife Conservation fees at FHL for the purpose of hunting and fishing are authorized by the Sikes Act. FHL hunting and fishing permit fees are established in accordance with AR 200-1. Current permit fees for hunting have been effective since 1 July 2008 and remain unchanged. Annual hunting permits are valid for a one year period from 1 July through 30 June of the following year. Two day hunting permits are valid for a two day period. Fishing permit fees are effective beginning 1 January 2010 and permits are valid for a one year period from 1 January through 31 December. The hunting and fishing permit years are concurrent with the California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) hunting and fishing license years. Fees are set at a fair market value for the State of California and provide a sliding fee scale for enlisted Soldiers as authorized by AR 200-1. Reduced fees for Officers are authorized per FHL Command. FHL permit fees are reduced or eliminated for persons qualifying for State of California reduced hunting and fishing license fees in accordance with Fish and Game Code, Section 7150 & Section 7151. See the enclosed tables of Fort Hunter Liggett hunting and fishing fees for specific fees by permit type and permit holder category.



5. PROCEDURES. Each hunting or fishing permit fee applicant will submit the appropriate application form with the correct fee according to the fee schedule and instructions accompanying the application. General public applications holding valid free or reduced fee CDFG hunting or fishing license must submit a copy of such license. Junior hunters must submit a copy of their CDFG junior hunting license. Military personnel must submit a copy of their Common Access Card (CAC) or other current documentation that demonstrates pay grade eligibility for reduced fee FHL hunting or fishing permits. All permit sales are final and not subject to refund, transfer between individuals, or between permit years.

³ Permit applicant must present a copy of a free CDFG fishing license, or must be an enlisted soldier with a pay grade of E-1 to E-4 (submit copy of Common Access Card or other documentation), or is a junior (less than 16 years old) to receive a no fee FHL fishing permit.
