MEMORANDUM FOR USAG FHL Soldiers, DOD Civilians, Contractors, and Tenant Units

SUBJECT: FHL Policy #17, Guidance for Subsisting in the Fort Hunter Liggett, Camp Parks, and BT Collins Dining Facilities

1. REFERENCES:

- a. AR 30-22, The Army Food Program, 10 May 2005
- b. DA Pam 30-22, Operating Procedures for the Army Food Program, 6 February 2007

2. PURPOSE: To provide guidance to USAG Soldiers, DOD Civilians, Contractors, and Tenant Units on personnel authorized to subsist in the US Army Garrison Dining Facilities (DFAC) located at Fort Hunter Liggett, Camp Parks, and BT Collins.


3. APPLICABILITY: These procedures are applicable to Soldiers' Families, Military Retirees (including Family Members), DOD Civilians, Contractors, and Tenant Units.

4. POLICY:

a. Effective immediately, DOD Civilians and Contractors registered in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) working on the installation are authorized to use garrison dining facilities on an occasional basis.

b. To ensure adequate support to Soldiers, who remain our primary customers, DOD Civilians and Contractors are limited to the last half hour of the published meal serving period. When the projected headcount equals or exceeds 90% seating capacity of the DFAC, a sign will be posted at the entrance, restricting access to Soldiers only. Soldiers and their Family Members in possession of PCS orders within 10 days of PCS may purchase meals regardless of these limitations.
