MEMORANDUM FOR US Army Garrison Fort Hunter Liggett (USAG FHL) Soldiers and Civilians

SUBJECT: FHL Policy #18, Ammunition and Explosives Training and Certification Program

1. REFERENCES.

- a. DA Pam 385-64, Ammunition and Explosives Safety Standards.
- b. AMC Regulation 350-4, Training and Certification Program for Personnel Working in Ammo Ops.
- c. IMCOM Regulation 5-13, Installation Ammunition Support.


2. PURPOSE. To establish an Ammunition and Explosives Training and Certification Program for all personnel involved in the handling, shipment, and processing of conventional ammunition, explosives, and explosive components.

3. APPLICABILITY. These procedures are applicable to all supervisors, civilian personnel, and military personnel involved in the handling, shipping, and processing of conventional ammunition, explosives, and explosive components assigned to and or under the operational control of USAG FHL.

4. POLICY. To establish and conduct an Ammunition and Explosives Training Certification Board consisting of the Director DOL or designate, the Director of DPTMS or designate, the Director Directorate of DHR or designate, Garrison Safety Officer (Chair), FHL Ammunition Supply Point (ASP) Manager, FHL Quality Assurance Specialist (QASAS) Representative, and DOL Chief, Supply and Services.

5. PROCEDURES. The Ammunition and Explosives Training Certification Board will meet semi-annually to review training requirements and certifications for all employees who are required to process, handle, ship, or transport ammunition, explosives, and explosive components. The board may also conduct interim reviews of training and certification for new or reassigned employees.

6. PROPONENT. The Installation Safety Office is the proponent for this policy. POC is the Installation Safety Officer at (831) 386-2790.
