MEMORANDUM FOR USAG Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) and Parks RFTA (PRFTA) Soldiers, Civilians, and Contractors (DoD personnel)

SUBJECT: FHL Policy #40, Foreign Travel Brief

1. REFERENCES.

- a. Army Regulation 380-67, Personnel Security Program, September 9, 1988.
- b. DoD Instruction 5240.6, August 7, 2004.
- c. Presidential Decision Directive/NSC No.12, Security Awareness and Reporting of Foreign Contacts, August 5, 1993.
- d. DoD Directive 5240.2, DoD Counterintelligence (CI), May 22, 1997.
- e. Executive Order 12829, National Industrial Security Program, January 6, 1993.

2. PURPOSE. To protect DoD personnel, information, resources, installations, and operations.

3. APPLICABILITY. These procedures are applicable to all FHL and Parks RFTA DoD personnel.

4. POLICY. All FHL and PRFTA DoD personnel are required to report all foreign travel 30 days in advance of the travel being performed to the FHL Security and Intelligence Office. All DoD personnel shall receive a Foreign Travel Briefing and have a current AT Level I certificate before their departure in order to protect their safety, DoD information, resources, installations, and operations. Traveler will notify the proponent of this memorandum.
