MEMORANDUM FOR US Army Garrison Fort Hunter Liggett (USAG FHL) Soldiers and Civilians

SUBJECT: FHL Policy #42, Wearing of Protective Headgear in Military Tactical Vehicles

1. REFERENCE.

- a. AR 385-10 The Army Safety Program.
- b. DoDI 6055.4 Traffic Safety Program Change.

2. PURPOSE. To provide guidance to USAG FHL Soldiers and civilians on the wearing of Protective Headgear in a Military Tactical Vehicles.

3. APPLICABILITY. These procedures are applicable to all civilian and military personnel assigned to and or under the operational control of USAG FHL.

4. POLICY. Effective immediately, head protection (Kevlar helmet, Combat Vehicle Crewmember (CVC), or flight helmet as appropriate) shall be worn by all operators and occupants of military tactical vehicles in a field environment on the installation.

a. Field environment is defined as a designated maneuver or training area (as depicted on Map, Fort Hunter Liggett, edition 003 or later) on the installation, or within the cantonment (garrison) area if conducting tactical field training (i.e., Tactical Operations Centers, Command Posts, etc.) in Garrison.

b. While traveling to and from the installation, and while operating military tactical vehicles in an administrative (non-tactical training) status (i.e., in post motor pools, around troop billeting areas, etc.) on FHL, the authority to prescribe required headgear rests with unit commanders.

c. Violation of this policy may subject personnel to disciplinary action. Installation command staff, Directorate of Plans, Training, Mobilization and Security, Range Operations, and FHL Police have the authority to enforce this policy.
