SUBJECT: Fort Hunter Liggett Policy #48, Assignment Priority and Designation of Housing Areas

1. REFERENCE. AR 420-1, dated 2 November 2007
2. PURPOSE. To establish housing assignment priorities and designation of housing areas by rank for army Family Housing for Military and Civilian Schedule of Equivalent Grades.
3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all personnel residing or requesting residency in Army Family Housing located at Fort Hunter Liggett, Ca.
4. POLICY. The Housing Office at Fort Hunter Liggett will use the Priority of Assignment for Family Housing established in AR 420-1, dated 2 November 2007. The following table designates the military and civilian schedule of equivalent grades for assignment, occupancy and termination of Army Family Housing located at Fort Hunter Liggett.

5. PROCEDURES. Housing may be assigned to personnel one pay grade category above or below that for which the housing is designated. Implementation will occur through attrition whether caused by Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders, employment changes, or for the convenience of the Government as determined by the Garrison Commander. All personnel affected by this policy will be afforded at least a 30-day notice to terminate quarters.
6. PROPONENT. The Directorate of Public Works, Housing Office is the proponent for this policy. Exceptions and questions regarding this policy should be directed to the Housing Manager, (831) 386-2075.
