SUBJECT: USAG FHL Policy #10-1, Standard Vehicle Inspections

1. REFERENCES.

- a. AR 190-13, Army Physical Security Program.
- b. AR 525-13, Antiterrorism.
- c. AR 190-56, Army Civilian Police and Security Guard Program.
- d. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision.

2. PURPOSE. To provide guidance on conducting systematic vehicle inspections.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all vehicles and drivers on U.S. Army Garrison Fort Hunter Liggett (USAG FHL) installations and sites.

4. POLICY.

a. The Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) has overall responsibility for the implementation of random vehicle inspections.

b. The Antiterrorism Officer develops recommendations for projected times, dates, locations and frequency of inspections. Inspections are identified and scheduled in advance and in accordance with the random antiterrorism measures (RAM) program. Random inspections are developed and forwarded through the Deputy to the Garrison Commander for my approval.


c. Vehicles may be stopped and inspected at installation gates, entry points, at posted restricted areas, and locations identified in the RAM program. In addition, stops and searches are possible in other areas when there is a reasonable suspicion of criminal activity or violation of a traffic regulation.

d. Inspections will comply with this policy and Police Department standard operation procedures that outline specific instructions on how inspections are organized and conducted.
