SUBJECT: USAG FHL Policy #10-2, Installation Fireworks

1. REFERENCES.

- a. Army Regulation 420-1, Army Facilities Management.
- b. Army Regulation 385-10, The Army Safety Program.

2. PURPOSE. To ensure the safety of everyone within the U.S. Army Garrison Fort Hunter Liggett (USAG FHL) community as it pertains to firework related accidents and injuries.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to members of the United States Armed Forces, Department of the Army Civilian employees, tenant and training units, contract personnel, residents, and visitors at USAG FHL.

4. POLICY. As the Commander, I am committed to the safety and welfare of everyone working, living, or visiting facilities at USAG FHL. The use of fireworks by individuals or groups is prohibited unless organized and approved by the command. Commercial agencies or groups using fireworks for public display and entertainment value must be licensed or certified as professional pyrotechnic operators by the State of California's Office of the Fire Marshal.

a. Fireworks are defined as any device containing chemical elements and chemical compounds capable of burning independently of the oxygen of the atmosphere and producing audible, visual, mechanical, or thermal effects, which are useful as pyrotechnic devices or for entertainment. This includes, but is not limited to, devices designated by the manufacturer as fireworks, torpedoes, skyrockets, roman candles, rockets, Daygo bombs, sparklers, party poppers, paper caps, chasers, fountains, smoke sparks, aerial bombs, and fireworks kits.

b. The sale, offer for sale, use, discharge, possession, storage, or transport of any type of fireworks within USAG FHL, to include Family housing, is prohibited without advance coordination with the Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) Fire Department and approval for the undersigned or authorized designee.
