SUBJECT: USAG FHL Policy #4-1, Assignment Priority and Designation of Housing Areas

1. **REFERENCE.** AR 420-1, Army Facilities Management
2. **PURPOSE.** To establish housing assignment priorities and designation of housing areas by rank for Army Family Housing for Military and Civilian Schedule of Equivalent Grades.
3. **APPLICABILITY.** This policy applies to all personnel residing or requesting residency in Army Family Housing located at Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL), California.
4. **POLICY.** The following tables designate the priorities of assignment and designation of housing areas to Army Family Housing at FHL. AR 420-1 authorizes Civilians to reside in Army Family Housing. These Civilians will pay the Fair Market Rental Rate established by the Department of the Interior, Internet Quarters Management Information Systems (iQMIS).
 - a. **Priorities of assignment:**

Priority 1	Key and essential military and Civilian personnel as determined by the Garrison Commander
Priority 2	Personnel in pay grades for whom the housing has been designated. Military personnel and Civilian employees attached for duty at the installation
Priority 3	Army personnel not assigned to the installation
Priority 4	DoD Civilian employees not assigned to the installation
Priority 5	Federal, State, and County employees not assigned to the installation
Priority 6	DoD contractors supporting the installation

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
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b. Housing area designations

Spanish Oaks	O1-O5 E8-E9	GS10-GS14	NF4-NF5	WS8-WS19
Abrams	E5-E7	GS5-GS9	NF3	WS1-WS7 WL1-WL5 WG9-WG11
Javelin	E1-E4	GS1-GS7	NF1-NF2	WG1-WG8

5. PROCEDURES. The Housing Office may assign personnel one pay grade category above or below an individual's housing designation. Implementation will occur through attrition whether caused by Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders, employment changes, or for the convenience of the Government as determined by the Garrison Commander. All personnel affected by this policy are afforded a 30-day notice to terminate quarters.

6. PROPONENT. The Directorate of Public Works is the proponent for this policy. POC is the Housing Manager at (831) 386-2075.
