SUBJECT: USAG FHL Policy #9-4, Qualified Recycling Program

1. REFERENCE: QRP Business Plan, Fort Hunter Liggett
2. PURPOSE: To establish Fort Hunter Liggett's Qualified Recycling Program (QRP) in accordance with the QRP Business Plan.
3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all personnel and activities on Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL).
4. POLICY:
  - a. All units, activities, and persons on FHL shall actively participate in the installation's QRP.
  - b. This program benefits the installation and all activities and persons on it by reducing waste streams, preventing pollution, encouraging recycling and conserving natural resources. It also supports Net Zero Waste objectives and environmental sustainment programs.
  - c. The efforts of all participants will result in direct revenue to the QRP that independently sustains the QRP program. If a revenue balance exists, remaining funds can be used at FHL for pollution abatement, energy conservation, occupational safety and health activities, and can be transferred to the non-appropriated Directorate of Family, Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR) account to be used for any morale and welfare activity.
